This is a 343 acre County park and natural area located nearby in Bridgewater Township. Operated by the Somerset County Park Commission, it is a site of rich natural beauty. Truly an "island" park, it is traversed by the historic Raritan Power Canal. Duke Island Park is a sanctuary for many of the plants and animals that are characteristic of the region. Its trails follow along the river and pass through the extensive wooded areas. Between the Raritan River and the canal, an open deciduous forest provides habitat for several species of owls and many deer and small animals. We will walk for about an hour on mostly level terrain.
