

# Fall Butterfly Walk

This walk will be led by Griffen Hurt, a wildlife research intern with the RVCC Center for Environmental Studies. Griffen surveyed meadows on Readington open space for butterfly abundance and diversity in 2020 and assisted in writing Readington Township's meadow management plan. The walk will focus on the tail-end of butterfly season and the importance of native fall blooming nectar sources. Last fall Vislocky had an abundance of Monarchs nectaring on goldenrods, so hopefully this year will be the same. This is a public event where all ages and experience are welcome. Binoculars and field guides will be provided, but bring your own if you have these.
