There will be inflatable attractions, a DJ, a concession stand, fire and police vehicles, and a Harlem Wizards game on the newly renovated basketball courts.
- c. **Summer Road Basketball Court Renovation:** Director Bolarakis said that the basketball court renovation process was underway and distributed pictures of the updates. A grand opening will be held at the Summer Spectacular. A discussion was also held about the progress of the walking path installation at Summer Road Park.
