A. CALL TO ORDER

D. OLD BUSINESS

1. **Winter Program Update:** Winter programs are running smoothly with many being at capacity. Recreation basketball for grades 2nd – 8th has 113 children registered and the Pre-K – 1st grade basketball has 85 children registered. Dina ran a three-week basketball clinic on Sundays in December and 25 children registered. The soccer programs have 29 children registered and the after-school tennis program has 24 children. The LEGO class is sold out with 24 children. The adult art programs have 26 registered, adult Zumba has 17, and yoga has 10 adults.

E. NEW BUSINESS

1. **2022 Readington Recreation Annual Report:** Gabrielle presented the Annual Report and noted the many highlights including but not limited to 14,601 people participated in Readington Recreation programs and 2022 program revenue increased \$61, 657.00 over 2021. The presentation was also shared with everyone via email.
2. **Spring/Summer Programs Update:** Gabrielle stated that program registration is up and running. Youth softball, spring soccer, and lacrosse numbers are normal. Many programs were opened slightly earlier than normal, and people are taking advantage. There are already over 40 children registered for summer camp, adult open play pickleball is almost sold out, and the youth specialty camps have had registration.
