Readington Township – The Readington Museums’ Bouman-Stickney Farmstead will be open for tours on **Sunday, November 3, 2024**, between 1:00 and 4:00 p.m. Come find out about the many histories at Readington Township's cherished museum. Learn how the Bouman-Stickney Farmstead got its name; why it became a museum; and about the programs offered. In addition, the 18th c. Wade-Wyckoff barn will be open for viewing. You can also hike the scenic [Bouman-Stickney Trail](#) that winds throughout the farmstead. The one-mile round-trip hike is part of the Round Mountain trail system.
