NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL ELECTION: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Due to COVID-19, Governor Murphy signed Executive Order #177 stating that the November 3rd General Election will be conducted *primarily by Vote by Mail*, with limited in person polling locations open on Election Day.

All “Active” registered voters will automatically receive a Vote by Mail Ballot.

Vote by Mail Ballots Can be Submitted in Several Ways:

1. **Hand-deliver** your ballot to the County Board of Elections Office located in the Historic Court House, 3rd Floor, 71 Main Street, Flemington.
2. **Deposit** your ballot in any of the twelve (12) secure drop boxes located throughout the County that has daily pickup. One of the secure drop boxes is located at the **Readington Township Municipal Building** in front of the Police Station/Municipal Building.
3. **Mail** your ballot through the US Postal Service in the return postage-paid enveloped (no stamp necessary) which will be included in the Vote by Mail Ballot packet that you will receive.
4. **Take** YOUR ballot – **you may not take anyone’s ballot but your own** – to the Readington Township’s polling place on Election Day, November 3rd, 2020, or if you do not have your Vote by Mail ballot you can cast a paper provisional ballot. Voters that are disabled and require an accommodation can vote on an ADA-accessible voting machine.

The designated Readington Township polling place located at **Holland Brook School** (52 Readington Road, Whitehouse Station) will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
