To Readington Township Residents and Businesses:

Readington Township is monitoring and following the guidance provided from Hunterdon County Health Dept. along with Centers for Disease Control (CDC), and NJ Dept. of Health officials as we closely monitor and respond to the outbreak of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (**COVID-19**).

Each department within Readington Township, including Administration, Emergency Management, Social Services and Police are working side by side to assure the safety of our staff and Township residents. Services needed by our residents is being provided safely and efficiently.

We are coordinating with Readington Township Police, Whitehouse First Aid & Rescue Squad, Readington Township Emergency Management and CERT, Readington Volunteer Fire Co., East Whitehouse Fire Dept., Whitehouse Station Fire Co. and Three Bridges Volunteer Fire Co., each of which has a plan in place to meet the challenges ahead of us.

When calling 9-1-1 or when requesting a response from emergency services, you might notice a different approach. Questions will be asked to assure the best use of resources and safest path for the services needed. This is necessary to maintain the safety and well-being of all parties involved.

Other changes include restricted access to the Police Department and the Municipal Building. These steps will allow for safer daily operations while still providing residents with necessary services.
