

REVISED PAVING SCHEDULE DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

Paving of the road will now begin on **Wednesday 11/4, Thursday 11/5, and Friday 11/6** (could possibly extend to a 4th day, Monday 11/) weather permitting.

Again, we anticipate the hours of closure to be approximately 7:00 am through 5:00 pm. We will have Flagger at each end of the project to communicate with motorists and allow **only** local traffic into the work zone. The work will begin at the Route 22 end heading east to finish up just after the Ryland Inn. Residents/businesses may experience a delay getting in or out of their driveway while the paving operation moves. As the paving progresses, it will need to be rolled and cooled to some degree before vehicles can drive on it. If you need to be somewhere at a certain time, please be aware of this (plan ahead, leave extra time, minimize trips, etc.) and make arrangements to move your vehicle if necessary before the paving operation gets to your home. Bear in mind the paving operation is continually moving which makes it difficult to predict exactly where and when individual residents will be impacted.
