Readington Township,

During the week of May 30 through June 2, 2023, the Township of Readington Department of Public Works (DPW) will be conducting sanitary sewer infiltration studies in the area of Three Bridges. This study will consist of placing NON-TOXIC engineered smoke into the sanitary sewer collection system. The safe smoke will follow the path of least resistance finding cracks, line breaks, illegal connections, missing cleanout caps and sources of inflow. The purpose of this study is to find areas of infiltration and inflow of unwanted ground water in the sanitary sewer system.

This test will produce a white smoke visible from around closed manhole covers in the roadway, building roof top sewer vents, and found infiltration and inflow areas. The smoke will dissipate quickly once testing is complete in that area. Testing areas will be clearly marked by road signage and a DPW presence.

If you see this white smoke, do not be alarmed. Speak to a DPW representative on site or contact us at the number below. We are working closely with local Emergency Services throughout the duration of this study to mitigate any potential confusion of true emergencies.
