Residents located in Lake Cushetunk

We are planning to have a contractor mill and pave the roads in this development beginning tomorrow, **Thursday, 11/1/18**.

This process will take several days to complete, and we need to have full access to the roadways. **All vehicles must be off the streets from 6 am through 6 pm, daily**, until the paving work has been completed. Vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

Once the road has been milled, manholes, catch basins, and valve boxes will be exposed above the pavement surface and painted for visibility. Be cautious while driving so as not to hit these with your tires. Also, be cautious while entering and exiting your driveway as the lip will be more than you were accustomed to.

The paving will commence a few days after the milling. The paving operation will move along quickly, however residents may experience a delay in being able to get in or out of their driveway as the paving operation is in front of their home. As the paving progresses, it will need to be rolled and cooled to some degree before vehicles can drive on it (**note:** with fresh asphalt, do not turn the steering wheel if you are not moving, make sure steering is accompanied by movement). If you need to be somewhere at a certain time, please be aware of this and make arrangements to move your vehicle before the paving operation gets to your home (plan ahead, leave early, park on Van Horne, minimize trips, etc.). Bear in mind the paving operation is continually moving which makes it difficult to predict exactly where and when individual residents will be impacted.
