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GENERAL INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

I. SUBMISSION OF QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Readington Township, Hunterdon County, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "TOWNSHIP") invites sealed bids pursuant to the Notice to Bidders.
- B. Sealed bids will be received by the designated representative at the time and place stated in the Notice to Bidders, and at such time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.
- C. The bid form shall be submitted, in a sealed envelope: (1) addressed to the TOWNSHIP, (2) bearing the name and address of the applicant written on the face of the envelope, and (3) clearly marked "RESPONSE VEHICLE".
- D. It is the applicant's responsibility to see that bids are presented to the TOWNSHIP on the hour and at the place designated. Bids may be hand delivered or mailed; however, the TOWNSHIP disclaims any responsibility for bids forwarded by regular or overnight mail. If the bid is sent by overnight mail, the designation in section C, above, must also appear on the outside of the delivery company envelope. Bids received after the designated time and date will be returned unopened.
- E. Sealed bids forwarded to the TOWNSHIP before the time of Receipt of bids may be withdrawn upon written application of the applicant who shall be required to produce evidence showing that the individual is or represents the principal or principals involved in the bid. Once bids have been opened, they must remain firm for a period of sixty (60) calendar days.
- F. All prices and amounts must be written in ink or preferably typewritten. Bids containing any conditions, omissions, unexplained erasures or alterations, items not called for in the bid form, attachment of additive information not required by the specifications, or the TOWNSHIP may reject irregularities of any kind. Any changes, whiteouts, strikeouts, etc. on the bid page must be initialed in ink by the person responsible for signing the bid.
- G. Each bid form must give the full business address of the applicant and be signed by an authorized representative. Bids by partnerships must furnish the full name of all partners and must be signed in the partnership name by one of the members of the partnership or by an authorized representative, followed by the signature and designation of the person signing. Bids by corporations must be signed in the legal name of the corporation, followed by the name of the State in which incorporated and must contain the signature and designation of the president, secretary or other person authorized to bind the corporation in the matter. When requested, satisfactory evidence of the authority of the officer signing shall be furnished.

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II. INTERPRETATION AND ADDENDA

- A. The applicant understands and agrees that its bid is submitted on the basis of the requirements prepared by the TOWNSHIP. The applicant accepts the obligation to become familiar with these requirements.
- B. Bidders are expected to examine the requirements with care and observe all their requirements. Ambiguities, errors or omissions noted by bidders should be promptly reported in writing to the appropriate official. In the event the applicant fails to notify the TOWNSHIP of such ambiguities, errors or omissions, the applicant shall be bound by the bid.
- C. No oral interpretation of the meaning of the specifications will be made to any applicant. Every request for an interpretation shall be in writing, addressed to the TOWNSHIP'S representative stipulated in the bid. In order to be given consideration, written requests for interpretation must be received at least five (5) days prior to the date fixed for the Receipt of the bids. Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda to the specifications, and will be distributed to all prospective bidders, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23. All addenda so issued shall become part of the contract documents and shall be acknowledged by the applicant in the bid. The TOWNSHIP'S interpretations or corrections thereof shall be final.

III. PREPARATION OF BIDS

A. The Township is exempt from any local, state or federal sales, use or excise tax.

IV. STATUTORY AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

A. Mandatory Affirmative Action Certification

No firm may be issued a contract unless it complies with the affirmative action regulations of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. (P.L.1975, c.127).

1. Procurement, Professional and Service Contracts

All successful vendors must submit, within seven days after the receipt of the notice of intent to award the contract or the receipt of the contract, one of the following:

- i. A photocopy of a valid letter for an approved Federal Affirmative Action Plan (good for one year from the date of the letter), or
- ii. A photocopy of an approved Certificate of Employee Information Report, or

iii. If the vendor has none of the above, the public agency is required to provide the vendor with an initial Affirmative Action Employee Information Report (AA-302).

B. Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990

Discrimination on the basis of disability in contracting for the purchase of bids and services is prohibited. The successful applicant is required to read Americans with Disabilities language that is part of this specification and agrees that the provisions of Title II of the Act are made a part of the contract. The successful applicant is obligated to comply with the Act and to hold the TOWNSHIP harmless.

C. Stockholder Disclosure

Chapter 33 of the Public Laws of 1977 provides that no corporation or partnership shall be awarded any contract for the performance of any work or the furnishing of any materials or supplies, unless, prior to the receipt of the bid or accompanying the bid of said corporation or partnership, there is submitted a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in the corporation or partnership who own ten percent or more of its stock of any class, or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a ten percent or greater interest therein. Form of Statement shall be completed and attached to the bid.

D. Non-Collusion Affidavit

The Non-Collusion Affidavit, which is part of these specifications, shall be properly executed and submitted with the bid.

E. New Jersey Business Registration Requirements

<u>Non-Construction Contracts</u> – The Contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the contractor.

Before final payment on the contract is made by the contracting agency, the Contractor shall submit an accurate list and the proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used.

For the term of the contract, the contractor and each of its affiliates and a subcontractor and each of its affiliates (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 (g) (3) shall collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and use Tax Act on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State, regardless of whether the tangible property is intended for a contract with a contracting agency.

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A business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required pursuant to Section 1 of P.L. 2001, c134 (C.52:32-44 et al) or subsection e. or f. of section 92 of P.L. 1977, c.110 (C.5:12-92), or that provides false business registration information under the requirements of either of those sections, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000 for each business registration copy not properly provided under a contract with a contracting agency.

Failure to submit this shall be cause for rejection of the bid.

V. METHODS OF AWARD

The contract will be awarded to the lowest price from the most responsible and responsive bidder.

VI. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

- A. If, through any cause, the successful applicant shall fail to fulfill in a timely and proper manner obligations under this contract or if the contractor shall violate any of the requirements of this contract, the TOWNSHIP shall thereupon have the right to terminate this contract by giving written notice to the contractor of such termination and specifying the effective date of termination. Such termination shall relieve the TOWNSHIP of any obligation for balances to the contractor of any sum or sums set forth in the contract.
- B. Notwithstanding the above, the contractor shall not be relieved of liability to the TOWNSHIP for damages sustained by the TOWNSHIP by virtue of any breach of the contract by the contractor and the TOWNSHIP may withhold any payments to the contractor for the purpose of compensation until such time as the exact amount of the damage due the TOWNSHIP from the contractor is determined.
- C. The contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the TOWNSHIP harmless from any liability to subcontractors/suppliers concerning payment for work performed or goods supplied arising out of the lawful termination of the contract by the TOWNSHIP under this provision.
- D. In case of default by the successful applicant, the TOWNSHIP may procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the successful applicant responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.

- 1. The Readington Township is seeking sealed bids for providing a RESPONSE VEHICLE as the per enclosed specifications.
- 2. All sealed bids shall be submitted to Richard J. Sheola, Township Administrator, 509 Route 523, Whitehouse Station, NJ 08889 by November 22, 2024 11:00 AM.
- 3. All bids shall include, at a minimum: the name, address and all contact information of the person or firm making the bid; a statement of qualifications; a statement of experience in rendering such services to public entities; and a bid for the vehicle.
- 4. All bids will be evaluated by Whitehouse Rescue, the Township Administrator of Readington Township with legal review by the Township Attorney.
- 5. Contract will be awarded by the Township Committee of Readington Township on the basis of the bids deemed to be most advantageous, price and other factors considered. The evaluation will consider:
 - a. Experience and reputation in the field;
 - b. Delivery schedule;
 - c. Price
 - d. Any and all exceptions to the bid specifications.

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BID SPECIFICATIONS

Chassis

One (1) 2024 or newer model year Chevy Tahoe SSV. Please see the attachment for options included in the vehicle.

CHASSIS WARRANTY

One (1) Premium Care extended warranty of 7 years / 125,000 miles with \$100 deductible shall be provided. It should be noted that the warranty provided shall explicitly recognize that the warranty is to cover an Emergency Vehicle used for Whitehouse Rescue Squad. A standard warranty for consumer vehicles will NOT be accepted. No Exceptions.

CUSTOM ELECTRICAL WIRING HARNESS

This conversion shall have a custom wiring harness throughout the vehicle. The harness shall integrate with the OEM factory plugs and connectors to avoid any splicing and cutting into the factory wiring harness. All wiring shall be GXL wire and function coded every 4" utilizing a minimum of 10 different colors and protected with high temperature loom. As industry standard, there will be no slices or connectors within any harness. The wiring shall have a snap ring grommet included where it passes through a wall.

CAB DOME LIGHT

One (1) Whelen 6" model #60CREGCS, wired ignition hot. Mounted in the front cab between the driver and passenger.

FRONT LIGHT BAR

Install a Whelen Legacy fully populated DUO light bar. Adjustable lightbar mount shall be included with installation. Shall include black mounting kit (MDAJ101) and midnight edition lenses (ES2ME).

FRONT PUSH BUMPER:

One (1) Westin Push Bumper Elite with Pit Bar Elite, Wing Wrap Elite, 33.1 4 head light channel with wire covers shall be mounted to the front of the vehicle.

FRONT WARNING:

Four (4) Whelen DUO smoked IONS shall be mounted in the grille area and four (4) additional Whelen DUO smoked ION shall be mounted in the wing wrap Pit area.

FLOOD LIGHT:

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One Whelen Summit 30" with R/B warning and marker lights shall be installed on the center of the front push bumper. The summit shall have two (2) 15' cables with flat low rising mounting kit.


