


Indian Purchase/Rocky Road Trails

Trailhead: Indian Purchase Rd, Near Intersection with Dreahook Rd, at Split Rail Fence.

Parking: Curbside, at the split rail fence, across from 2 Indian Purchase Rd, Whitehouse Sta.



This trail system is on Readington Township land preserved as a result of the approval of the Indian Purchase Road (Stanton Place) neighborhood development.

The white blazed main trail begins at the corner of the field adjacent to Indian Purchase Rd, proceeds to the foot of Cushtunk Mountain. It then climbs up the mountainside, at first in a gradual manner, and then, steeply to the Summit. At about 6/10 mile, after crossing under a powerline, the footing becomes very treacherous, over broken rock, and is recommended only for hikers with good balance, using trekking poles.

The red blazed trail loop avoids the difficult footing of the white trail by following the level powerline cut before ascending the mountain in a less rocky location, and then rejoining the white trail at the summit.

These trails have not been connected to trails in Round Valley Recreation Area or Hunterdon County parkland.

Please remain on the marked trails to avoid trespassing on nearby private land.
