

Saums Farm Trail

Location: Across from 115 Rockafellows Mill Rd, Flemington, NJ 08822
Trailhead and Parking Lot



As part of the preservation of the 109 acre Floyd Saums Farm in 2020, this 50 acre tract was sectioned off and acquired by the township for permanent open space. The entire cost of the farm's preservation was covered by State, county and nonprofit funding and the auction of the remaining property as a preserved farm.

The orange blazed loop trail travels around the perimeter of a large level open field. To the south of the loop are two majestic White Oaks estimated to be about 250 years old, among the oldest in the township, and on the west side of the loop a huge black oak of unknown age. In winter and spring a portion of this trail can be covered with standing water.

The blue trail loop winds an additional half mile over moderate inclines through a mix of wetlands and early successional woodland dominated by eastern red cedars. The State's South Branch Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is adjacent to this trail, however there is currently not a marked connection to the WMA pathways.

This map does not show property boundaries. The green indicates wooded areas, not the extent of the open space.
